Post-acute and rehabilitation care



- ▼ To provide medical care and rehabilitation services following surgery or an acute episode of a chronic illness
- Both on inpatient and outpatient basis
- With high-quality technical platform and advanced technologies
- In France, Germany, Austria, Poland, Italy, Switzerland
- Strong development and interest in all the countries in order to:
 - Reduce the length of stay in acute-care hospitals
 - Reduce the cost for public / private insurance
 - Accelerate and improve the rehabilitation of workers and elderly

Geriatric post-acute	 For patients of 75 and over and with high risk of dependency For polypathological patients
Haemato-oncological post-acute	 Care for patients post related-cancer surgery Care for patients with chemotherapy treatment
Functional re-education	 Care for patients after orthopaedic surgery and traumatology Post hip or knee replacements, post spinal surgery care, chronic back pain
Neurology	 Readjustment relating to neurological complaints such as stroke Patients with a degenerative neurological disease (preventive, therapeutic actions)
Cardiovascular post-acute care	 Follow-on care for cardiac and vascular patients (bypass) Care following cardiological intervention (stent) and cardiac prosthesis (artificial heart or transplant)
Respiratory post-acute care	 Readjustment following cardiothoracic surgery Care following lung transplant or lung reduction surgery for cancer
Highly specialized rehabilitation care units	 Patients in vegetative state, ventilated patients Specialised units for children with cardiovascular or respiratory disease

- ➤ Different hospital status: full hospitalisation, outpatient, in-patient hospitals for socially isolated patients who can go to the clinic in the evening for psychological support and assistance
- Multi-disciplinary team and variety of psychotherapeutic approaches: psychotherapists, occupational therapists, art therapists, sport physiotherapists

Specific and non-drug innovative equipments




Specific equipments depending on the medical plan and the pathologies treated:

- Neurofeedback using an electro-encephalographic to teach patients self-control of brain functions
- Electro-convulsive therapy highly effective in cases of severe depressive episodes or treatmentresistant major depressive disorder
- ➤ Deep Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS) is used to treat depression, post-traumatic stress disorder, addiction or obsessive-compulsive disorders (OCD)
- Virtual Reality Therapy (used to treat phobias, eating disorders and addictions) consists of immersing the patient in a virtual environment related to the disorder

Acquisition of Clinica Holistica



- Psychiatric clinic focusing exclusively on stress-related diseases using various psychiatric and therapeutic approaches (physiotherapeutic, art, quigong, music etc)
- Created in 2010 and recently renovated to high standards
- Premium facility of 61 beds with possibility of being extended
- Daily price of CHF 460 for the accommodation
- Located in Susch, a very peaceful place in Switzerland









Creation in Veyrier (Geneva)



- Dual care offer: psychiatric with a focus on mood disorders (14 beds) and functional re-education (28 beds)
- Those two cares are lacking in the Geneva canton
- Premium facility offering high-performance technical equipment platform
- ➤ Daily price of CHF 750 1,000
- Opening in 2018

Development in Spain: acquisition of a highly reputed psychiatric hospital in Madrid





- Clinic López Ibor, founded in 1965, has 70 private rooms
- Very well-known medical institution specializing in mental illness and disorders, previously managed by the ex-president of the World Psychiatric Association
- ➤ Premium location: Madrid (Puerta de Hierro) in a quiet residential area and well communicated to the city center with significant additional land surface to be built



- ▼ Diversified and high quality offer:
 - Psychiatric hospitalization
 - External practices (psychiatry, neuropsychology, neuropsychiatry and psychology)
 - Emergency psychiatric services
 - Day hospital services
- Agreements with 30 insurance companies and mutual companies such as Adeslas, Axa, Aegon, Allianz, Asisa, DKV, Mapfre, etc.

Acquisition of Woonzorgnet in the Netherlands





RET



- Founded in 2005, Woonzorgnet is a private healthcare provider of psychiatric care (sheltered housing, day care and outpatient living)
- Network: 7 facilities / 162 beds, a model adapted to the country culture
- WZN benefits from an excellent reputation amongst both clients and municipalities and provides:
 - Sheltered housing, day care and outpatient living support
 - Personal assistance by personal coordinator and living facilitation
 - Electronic client file
 - Daytime activities
 - Learning modules such as psychological well being, empowerment, healthy eating and exercise, personal care and hygiene

Poland: new greenfield mixing nursing homes, Rehab and assisted living



- ➤ Purchase of several buildings of which some are classified in the historical center of Poznan: a unique and prestigious part of the City Center of Poznań; just a few steps away from The Old Market Square, which is the pride of the city of Poznań

- Creation of a healthcare complex of 3 buildings / 400 beds :
 - 1 nursing home 166 beds
 - 1 assisted living 73 apartments
 - 1 rehab clinic 158 beds
 - Ambulatory care and home care

Development of Salvea outpatient centers in Germany





- "Ambulatorisation" in the German rehabilitation market: ambulatory rehabilitation cases have grown by 13% every year between 2000 and 2014
 - Cheaper (approx. 30%) solution than stationary rehab. for insurers
 (Between 2005 and 2014, payments related to ambulatory rehabilitation have increased by 70% to 100% depending of the insurance)
 - Requested by the patients: more than 40% of patients want more ambulatory rehabilitation offers
 - Developments in medical technology and treatments reducing needs for stationary rehabilitation
- ➤ Founded in 2003, Salvea (=Inoges) is a market leader in Germany, primarily engaged in outpatient centers in rehabilitation and therapeutic services
- 31 units taking care of more than 5 million patients per annum with 1,000 employees
- Revenue of more than €50m
- ➤ Location of the facilities in urban areas with good local infrastructure in attractive federal stares with high income (i.e. North-Rhine Westphalia, Hesse and Bavaria)
- ➤ Strong recognition and reputation of Salvea brand: ISO 9001-certified quality management, a norm that is recognized nationally and internationally as the most important certification in quality management




